SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION FOR THE 2012-2013 ACADEMIC YEAR

General Information

The National Capital Texas A&M Club's Scholarship Fund exists to support the education goals of current and prospective Texas A&M University students. Scholarships are awarded based on applicant's character, leadership potential, quality of application and grade point average. The amount of the scholarship award and number of scholarships will be determined based on the quality of applicants. The announcement of the scholarship award will be made annually at the club barbecue typically held during the month of August. The winner of the scholarship will be notified by telephone in advance of the barbecue and invited to attend as a guest of the club.

Scholarship Eligibility Requirements

- Applicants must be a resident of the Washington, DC Metropolitan area / National Capital Region.
- Applicants must be a current student or have been accepted for studies in graduate/undergraduate course work at Texas A&M University at the College Station or Galveston campuses.
- Previous recipients of the National Capital Texas A&M Club Scholarship may reapply.
- The award of the scholarship is contingent upon acceptance and enrollment at Texas A&M University or proof of good academic standing with the University.
- Applications must be received by April 20, 2012

- The applicant's character, leadership potential, quality of application, financial need and grade point average.
- Three letters of recommendation must be included in the application packet. At least two recommendations must be from a principal, guidance counselor, clergy, university advisor, teacher or professor.
- A final interview with the Scholarship Committee (If requested by the Committee).

Scholarship Committee

The Scholarship Committee consists of five active members of the club to include officers and board members. Each packet is reviewed and ranked on criteria as stated in the above information. The decision of the Scholarship Committee is final.
